Hanley Castle High School is a high performing academy set in the most beautiful and peaceful rural surroundings. Founded in 1326, it is an oversubscribed, vibrant and successful 11-18 school which serves a large geographical area. Our sustained academic success attracts students from Upton, Worcester, Malvern, Herefordshire and North Gloucestershire.

Hanley Castle has an excellent reputation locally and nationally for academic excellence. It has been recognised at national level for its excellent GCSE results, with around 30% of all grades being awarded at either A or A* grade. Areas of strength include English, mathematics, sciences and the humanities.

Our Sixth Form is an enormously popular option for post-16 studies with around 200 students drawn from schools across the area. This year we will again be sending large numbers of high achieving students to Oxford, Cambridge and Russell Group universities.

A unique blend of innovation and traditional values, the school has cutting edge IT facilities, brand new science facilities, a fabulous new sixth form centre and a magnificent sports hall which will be refurbished by December 2018. This is balanced by a thriving College system and an outstanding culture of music, dance, drama, sport and an exchange programme with China.
