#### How best to revise for this subject:

(activities, how long, when, revisiting ideas ...)

Start early with answering exam questions.

- Use the specification for each topic to identify areas you're not confident on - these are the areas you should prioritise for revision.
- Use your notes and revision guide for the key understanding such as key terms.
- Summarise key parts of topics into spider diagrams e.g. case studies
- Use Brainscape to learn key facts and case studies.
- Practise exam questions using your exam question booklets, then mark them using the answers in the back.
- Have a go at exam questions without using your notes, then, using a different colour, use resources/answers to improve your answer.
- Use Educake and complete quizzes for topics you know you need to work on.
- Develop key terminology to improve your extended writing answers.
- Use model answers from class to improve your responses.
