<p><u>Your Y11 Mock Exams</u></p> <p>Title and length of paper(s):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Paper 1 USA 1919-1975 (1 hour) Paper 2 Normans 1066-1100 (1 hour) <p>Style(s) of question:</p> <p>USA will have 6 questions. Q1-3 will be one interpretations of an event looking at how they are different, why they are different, and which is most convincing. Q4 will ask you to describe two features of an event, Q5 will be to explain two things about an event whilst Q6 will ask you to explain two factors and link them in an extended answer.</p> <p>Normans will have a convincing source question, an explanation question, a write an account question and a 16-mark, factor question with links.</p>		<p>How best to revise for this subject: (activities, how long, when, revisiting ideas ...)</p> <p>Do revision in short sharp bursts. Improve subject knowledge using Educake and the online Brainscape cards or if you have Quizlet look at the links.</p> <p>I like to use a whiteboard to try to memorise and retrieve information. Take a box on a knowledge organiser and spend 5 minutes learning it. Cover it over and try and write down everything you remember on a whiteboard. Keep trying until the majority sticks.</p> <p>Buy a revision guide and attempt some of their tasks.</p> <p>You also have questions in the exam booklets which go with knowledge booklets for Normans and Asia, so attempt some of these too.
