Title and length of paper(s):

- 1. Speaking:
 - **7-9 min (F tier), 10-12 min (H tier)** + 12 min preparation time
- 2. Listening and understanding:
 - 35 min (F tier), 45 min (H tier) incl. 5 min reading time
- 3. **Reading** and understanding in French:
 - 45 minutes (F tier), 1 hour (H tier)
- 4. Writing in French:
 - 1 hour 15 minutes (F tier), 1 hour 20 minutes (H tier)

Style(s) of question:

Speaking (both tiers):

- Task 1: a role play task consisting of 5 bullet points
- **Task 2**: a picture-based task, consisting of a picture description and 4 linked questions
- Task 3: a conversation with questions based on two different themes

Listening: Multiple-choice and short-answer open response questions:

- Foundation Tier: Section A has questions set in English. Section B has questions set in French/German.
- Higher Tier: Section A has questions set in French/German.
 Section B has questions set in English.

Reading: multiple-choice and short-answer open response questions:

- Section A has questions set in English.
- Section B has questions set in French/German.
- Section C is a translation passage from French/German <u>into</u> <u>English</u>.

Writing: The writing tasks depend upon your Tier of entry:

- Foundation Tier:
 - **Task 1** Describe a picture and give opinions (20-30 words)
 - Task 2 Write a 40–50-word text linked to four bullet points, using formal register. You have a choice of 2 questions.
 - Task 3 Write an 80–90-word text linked to four bullet points, using informal register. You have a choice of 2 questions.
 - **Task 4** Translation of 5 short sentences from English <u>into French/German</u>.

- Higher Tier:

- Task 1 Write an 80–90-word text linked to four bullet points, using informal register. You have a choice of 2 questions.
- Task 2 Write a 130–150-word text linked to four bullet points, using formal register. You have a choice of 2 questions.
- **Task 3** Translation a short paragraph from English <u>into</u> <u>French/German</u>.

Prepare and practise answers to questions from your speaking & writing exam preparation booklets:

- Every week
- As often as possible
- In manageable chunks e.g. 4
 questions & answers at a time
 (ask your teacher for specific
 guidance)
- Create flashcards with questions and answers

Grammar revision, such as conjugating verbs in different tenses:

- As often as possible
- Activities from your GCSE Revision workbook
- Choose a number of key verbs from a topic and conjugate them in at least the past, present and future tenses

Review all topic vocabulary:

- In bitesize chunks on a regular basis (rather than a large amount all at once)
- o You could:
 - Use Quizlet vocabulary sets
 - Create flashcards using your topic vocabulary lists

Review language to describe a picture. You could:

- Use Quizlet vocabulary sets
- Create flashcards using language from the "photo description" sheets in your folder
- Choose a photo and write/say as much as you can about it.

Review language to justify opinions:

- Use Quizlet vocabulary sets to review opinion phrases and connectives
- Practise giving your opinions in French on anything you can, remembering to add a reason
